

**Central Senior High School Dress Code
2013- 2014**

9th – 12th Grade Uniforms

- Polo style shirts (plain, **solid color, 3 buttons or less**)
- Students are required to wear white crew neck undershirts.
- Hair color is restricted to all natural colors or colors in the Central color scheme.
- No head coverings; **head wraps**; or **bandanas**.
- Headbands should be Dress code colors only.
- Students are not allowed to wear soft sole shoes (house shoes, athletic slides, or flip flops).
- Solid / matching socks .One pair of socks worn at a time. No two different colored socks.
- **Plain, solid color crewneck sweatshirts / or with Central approved logo maybe worn during the week with a collared shirt. The color of the sweatshirt must match the colors of the tops (listed above)**
- **Central Hoodies worn on Friday only. These may be purchased from the bookstore.**
- Shorts, skirts, skorts must be finger –tipped length or the length of a dollar bill above the knee.
- **Spirit wear is subject to administrative guidelines and prior approval.**
- No technological devices (**cell phones, headphones, ear buds, I-pads, etc.**) allowed in class or in the hallways.

*******Parents please emphasize with your students:**

- Females are not permitted to wear **leggings, jeggings, skinny jeans, or skinny khakis jeans, tight fitting pants with or without pockets.** Leggings or tights may not be worn under shorts.
- **No jeans (including regular levis or colored levis) or jean material; No cut-offs; No khaki colored jeans.**

Khaki or Black slacks / docker style pants; black* or white* button down oxford style shirt (must be tucked in); necktie in Central School solid or patterned colors of red/black/white

Young Ladies

Khaki skirt / black* or white* button down oxford style shirt.

Team Shirt or Dress code colors (solid)
