

**EAST CENTRAL JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL  
DRESS CODE  
2011-2012**

Students at East Central Junior High School should avoid conspicuous or inappropriate attire and all parents should encourage an appearance that enhances the academic climate of the school. Below are the guidelines that will be followed in determining appropriate attire:

- All students must wear shoes. (NO house shoes or house slippers)
- **Only solid white or black socks are acceptable.** NO designs or striped socks are allowed.
- Students are not allowed to wear hats in the building.
- Students are prohibited to **“SAG”** their pants.
- All students must wear their shirts tucked in. (The only exception is girl’s camp shirts)
- Large or ornate belt buckles are prohibited. (Only standard buckles are allowed)
- Shorts, skirts, & dresses must be fingertip length minimum. (arms hanging straight down)
- Any type of clothing or any manner of grooming which is offensive or suggestive and thus interferes with the educational process must be corrected immediately.
- No intentionally ripped or torn articles of clothing will be allowed.
- **Students will avoid coloring their hair purple, green, blue, red, maroon or any of the neon colors. Only natural colors are acceptable. Hair must be groomed appropriately and not be a distraction to the educational setting.**
- **NO body piercing except earlobes.**
