2016-17 School Uniforms

Shirts/Tops/Sweatshirts:

- Students are allowed to wear uniform tops that are Black, White, or Gray (Maroon colored tops are reserved for 8th Graders).
- Uniform tops must be plain, solid-colored, polo-styled (2 or 3 buttons and a **collar**) short or long sleeved shirts.
- Undershirts that are visible must be white or black (solid colored and plain).
- Uniform colored non-hooded, plain sweatshirts can be worn for winter months.
- Hooded sweatshirts are considered outer wear and must be placed in scholar's locker (in addition to jackets, coats, sport-packs/backpacks, and oversized bags/purses) for the duration of the school day.

Pants/Shorts/Skirts:

- Students are allowed to wear only khaki styled slacks (cargo styled pants, denim, wind pants, or sweatpants are unacceptable).
- Uniform pants can be either Tan or Black.
- Uniform style shorts/skirts MUST conform to our District Dress Code – 3" from the floor when kneeling – well below fingertips.
- Bottoms Must be properly fitted – not oversized
- No flared or fringed hems allowed.

Note:

- Uniform shall be neat and clean
- Closed toe and heel shoes with socks – flip flops/sandals not allowed.

- Administration reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of students' dress. Parents will be required to bring appropriate clothing to the Main Office if it is determined that a student is not properly dressed.

***Physical Ed. Uniform:**

Students who will attend Physical Education classes will need to bring clothing for suiting out for gym every day. The requirements for PE uniform are below:

- Shorts or sweatpants that are an appropriate length and well fitted. (Basketball shorts are preferred as a guideline for length.)
- T-shirts that are plain Black, White, or Grey.
- Tennis shoes, basketball shoes, or sneakers

Attendance:

Attendance is vital to the success of students in 7th grade. Students are expected to arrive on time to school each day (please see bell schedule below), in uniform and with proper supplies. We understand that emergencies, sickness, and circumstances may occasionally keep a child from school. Parents are required to call the school and inform us of a student's absence with each occurrence. *Please note that only absences documented with a doctor's note will be denoted as EXCUSED.*
